Hunters Namibia Safaris

Namibia 2014

Hunters Namibia Safaris features a hunting area that is privately owned by the outfitter owners/founders, the Lamprechts, and covers over 50,000 acres of pristine wilderness area populated only by free ranging game. An adjoining property adds another 40 square miles to the hunting area. There are 24 species of huntable game as well as an impressive variety of game birds (depending on the season) that are available for trophy hunters and wing shooting enthusiasts. Many additional species can be viewed and photographed. On a Hunters Namibia safari, a minimum of 500 game animals will be seen in one day while hunting.

Clients have two lodges to choose from when on safari with Hunters Namibia: the Main Lodge and the Lake Lodge, both of which are run in the classic, elegant style of traditional safari camps. The lodges are spacious buildings of natural stone with thatched roofs, designed to blend in with the surrounding rocky kopjes and vast savannahs. Both lodges offer guest suites with en-suite bathrooms – all in sophisticated, distinctly-safari style. One of the favorite features of these lodges is that they are strategically placed near water holes to allow game viewing and photography from your suite and sun decks.

- The Namibian trophy hunting season runs from February 1st to November 30th annually
- Minimum period of 8 hunting days is required (14 days is recommended by outfitter)
- For Cheetah, Leopard and Sable a minimum period of 14 days is required
- Lake Lodge can accommodate maximum 4 guests
- Main Lodge can accommodate maximum 10 guests
- Camps will never be shared with other hunts

- Weapon hire for any other rifle priced upon request
- Ammo for .300 calibre and under \$4 per round
- Ammo for .375 and up priced upon request
- Transport to other areas (at clients' request) \$1.20/km
